



# Wildcat Math is back for 2015-2016

Wildcat Math is a 16 week program, sponsored by the PTA that builds math skills. It is based on the principles of Love & Logic as it teaches responsibility and commitment. It is open to all students and everyone is encouraged to participate.

Each week, students will complete a worksheet for their grade level. Worksheets must be returned to the Wildcat Math boxes located in front of the Library by Friday at 8:15 a.m. Worksheets are available to download from home at [www.wsespta.com](http://www.wsespta.com) the previous Saturday morning, or they may be obtained on Monday at school. 1 extra bonus point will be given for each worksheet printed at home plus an additional 5 points will be given at the end of the year for PTA membership.

Prizes will be given during the program and at the close of the program based on number of weeks participated. New for the 2015-2016 school year, Wildcat Math will be awarding "spirit sticks" at the 4, 8, 12 and 16 week benchmarks for participation. Be on the lookout for more information regarding the new spirit stick incentive program being sponsored by the PTA at the beginning of the school year. At the end of the year an awards ceremony will be held and students who participated all 16 weeks will be honored.

Class scores will be posted on the Wildcat Math wall and a traveling trophy will be presented to the class with the most participants. The winners will also be posted on the Wildcat Math website at [www.wsespta.com](http://www.wsespta.com) on the Weekly Winner page. Also, make sure to keep checking the website for any changes or announcements.
